[Canadian Gambling Digest 2007 - 2008](#)

Canadian Partnership for Responsible Gambling. (2009).

In 2004, a group of non-profit organizations, gaming providers, and gaming regulators came together to form the Canadian Partnership for Responsible Gambling (CPRG). The Partnership was formed in order to find and promote effective ways to reduce the risk of problem gambling by engaging in joint research, issue analysis, and information sharing. The first priority of the Partnership was the assembly of reliable and accurate gambling-related information across the country. The result was the Canadian Gambling Digest, an annual report of statistics related to gambling in each of the ten Canadian provinces. This edition of the Digest is the sixth report released to date.

### [Call for Applications: 2009-2010 Graduate Studentship Program](#)

The purpose of the Fellowship Program is to develop the capacity in Ontario to conduct problem gambling research. The Ontario Problem Gambling Research Centre accomplishes this by providing financial support to students who undertake problem gambling research as part of their graduate studies programs and show promise for a career in problem gambling research. Studentship awards have been increased and extended as part of a program redesign. Doctoral Studentships are valued at \$20,000 per year for up to three years and \$17,500 for up to two years at the Masters level. Doctoral and Masters Studentships can also be awarded as part of an Emerging Team Award. At the time of application, candidates must be registered as a full-time student in a Masters or Doctoral program at a recognized Canadian university, and anticipate completion of their program within three years.

Deadline for applications is May 15th, 2009.
